

Rules of conduct of members of the Albion Fish & Game Club August 2001

1. Each member shall be responsible for cleaning, restoring, or replacing any article or condition that has been devalued or abused by their actions.
2. Each member is responsible for the actions of their guests. Except for Club functions no guests are allowed without the presence of a host member. The host member must be a Regular Member in Good Standing. The host Member is obligated to rule 1 (above) for the actions of any guest(s) as if they were his own.
3. Alteration, destruction, or removal of Club property is forbidden without the express consent of two members of the Board of Directors or membership approval made at a regular business meeting.
4. No trash or discarded items are to be left on the property. Material left in proper receptacles during the course of appropriate activities is a noted exception.
5. The Club will not reimburse or compensate for any purchase, agreement, service, or loss to any member or their guest without approval by a majority of members in good standing at a regular business meeting.
6. The Clubhouse and grounds are not to be used as a base for commercial enterprise. Exceptions must have the pre-approval of a majority of members in good standing at a regular business meeting.
7. Appropriate safety measures will be observed at all times.
8. Firearms will only be discharged on the designated ranges and only between 9:00 am and sunset. Firearms will not be discharged when the grounds or clubhouse are rented out. Spent cartridges are to be removed from club property by the shooter. (Shell casings cause damage and present a danger to lawn mowers).
9. Renters are bound by these same rules. Renters do not have the privileges of Club members, e.g. use of the firing ranges. All participants at a Club-rented function are obligated in the same manner.
